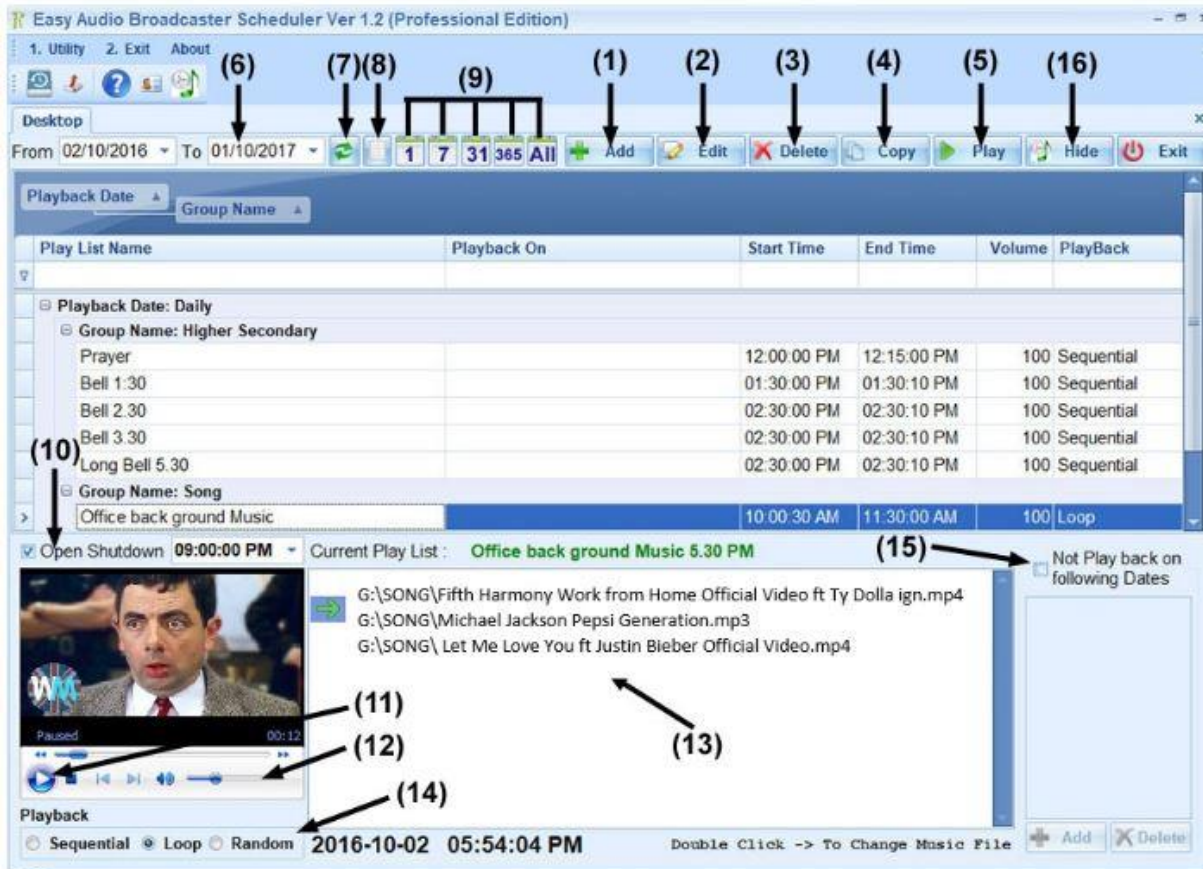




How to Use Software

The main interface of the software

A brief introduction to the buttons of the main window



- (1) Add -> Add new Play List
- (2) Edit -> To edit existing Play List (first select Play List from Grid), Double click Or Enter key to edit PlayList
- (3) Delete -> To delete Play List (first select PlayList from Grid)
- (4) Copy -> To copy current PlayList to new Play List (first select Play List from Grid)
- (5) Play -> Manually load(Play) Play List (first select PlayList from Grid)
- (6) Set 'From Date - To Date' -> Press Refresh(7) button to load playlist in Grid. Load play List of between dates (Specific Date), Daily and Weekly.
- (7) Refresh -> To Fill Data in grid
- (8) Quick date range Selection
- (9) Load Play List task of the following Range
 - 1 -> Set Today's Date
 - 7 -> Set Next 7 days date range
 - 31 -> Set Next 31 days date range
 - 365 -> Set Next 365 days date range
 - All -> All PlayList task
- (10) Open Shutdown -> once you check out this check box then the computer will shutdown on specific time.
- (11) Toggle Play/Pause current music file.
- (12) Move the slider to Change Volume Up/Down.
- (13) Double click to change the Music file manually in the current list.
- (14) Playback Modes: there are three modes- Sequential playback, Loop playback and Random playback.
- (15) Not Play Back on the Following Dates (check box): only when checked, the content of this part can be operated :
 - On holidays such as Christmas, New Year Day etc broadcast is not generally played back, you can set these dates in advance.
- (16) Hide -> Software will minimize to quick launch bar

Main Short Cut :

F2 -> Pause/Play
F3 -> Change Playback
F4 -> Focus on Play List
F5 -> Focus on 'From Date'
F6 -> Refill Play List Task List
F7 -> Quick Date Range Selection
F8 -> Today's Task
F9 -> Task of Next 7 Days
F10 -> Task of Next 31 Days
F11 -> Task of Next 365 Days
F12 -> All Task
Alt+H -> Minimize Software to quick launch bar
Alt+X -> Exit

Playback List Shortcut :

Alt+A -> Add New Play List
Enter -> Edit Play List (or Double click)
Ctrl+Y -> Delete Current Play List (Require focus on the grid for this)
Alt+P -> Load current PlayList and Play

Not Playback on following Dates Shortcut :

Ctrl+N -> Add PlayBack Stop Date
Ctrl+Y -> Delete Current Playback Stop Date (Require focus on the list for this)

 - Loop Playback (When the last music file is played then Play first
 music file in the list)
 - Random playback (Randomly play music file of the list)

Media File List :

Add Button -> Add Music file(s)
Delete Button -> Delete Music file from the list (first select file from the list)
 For to delete Selected files
 - Hold the 'Ctrl key and press the 'Space Bar' key to select a file
 and press the Up/Down Arrow key
 - Hold the 'Ctrl' key and click on music file by mouse to select
 media file.
 - Ctrl+A -> Select All Media files
Delete All Button -> Delete all Music files from a list
Move Up Button -> Move Music file to Upside (first select file from the list)
Move Down Button -> Move Music file to Downside (first select file from the list)

Add Web URL to Play List(here you can set live radio station-streaming URL for listening)

Some users need for timed playback of network broadcast (for example you want
to playback network news and music) here Paste the address of streaming media broadcast
in
text box and press Add button to add URL to PlayList

Short Cut :

Alt+T -> To focus on Start Time
Alt+L -> To focus on Media File List
Alt+A -> Add Media File
Ctrl+Y -> Delete current Media File from the list (first select file from the list)
Ctrl+A -> (Require focus in media file list) Select all Media Files
Ctrl+Delete -> Delete All Media Files from list
Alt+U -> Move Music file to Up side (first select file from list)
Alt+D -> Move Music file to Down side (first select file from list)
Ctrl+U -> Add Web URL to Medifa File List
Alt+S -> Save And Close window
Esc -> Cancel And Close window

Backup

Click on Menu [1. Utility] -> [A. Backup]



(1) Click on the button to change the backup path

(2) Check this for date wise Backup

Click On Backup button to backup (Alt+B)

(Note: The only PlayList and setting Backup, Backup does not contain music files)

Restore

Click on Menu [1. Utility] -> [B. Restore]



(1) Select Audio Main. SDF For Restore backup
Click On Restore button to Restore data (Alt+R)

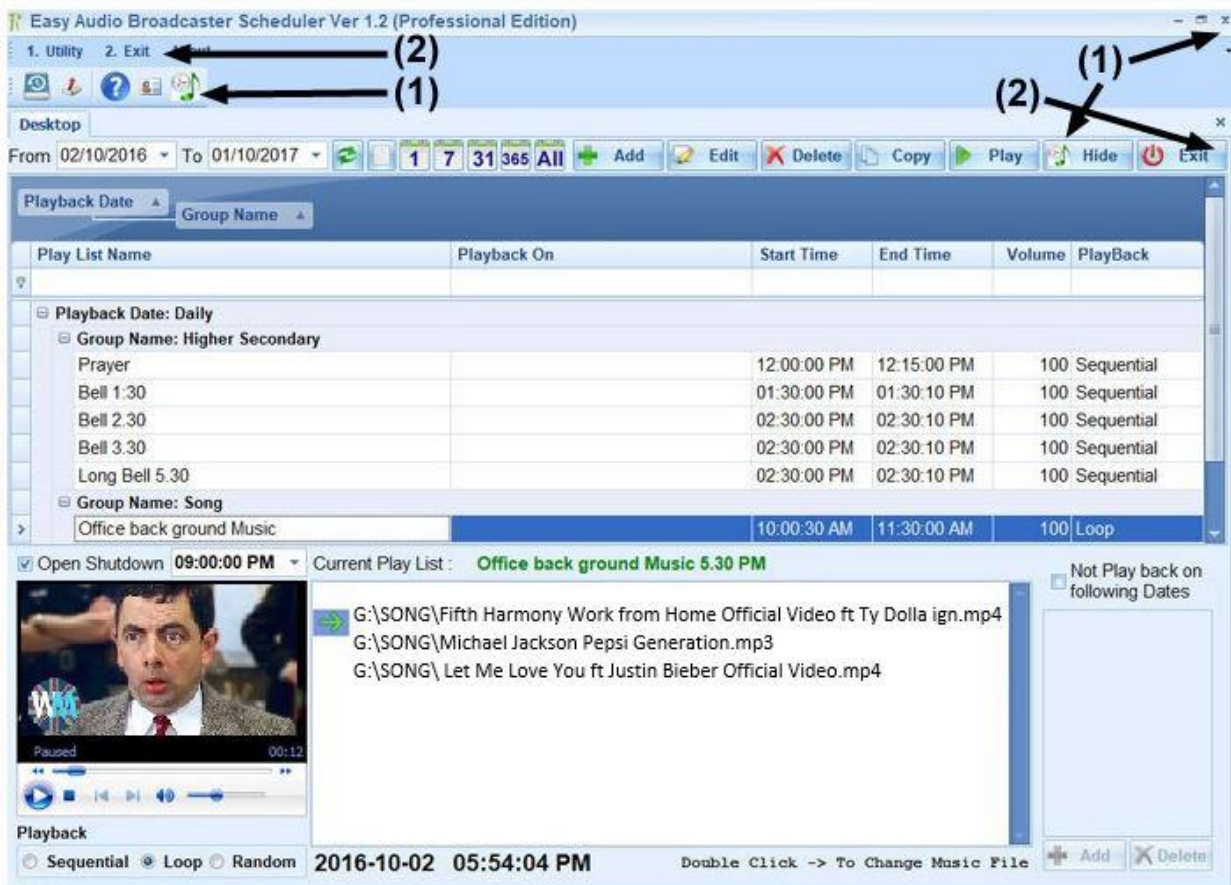
How to Add/Remove Play List Group
